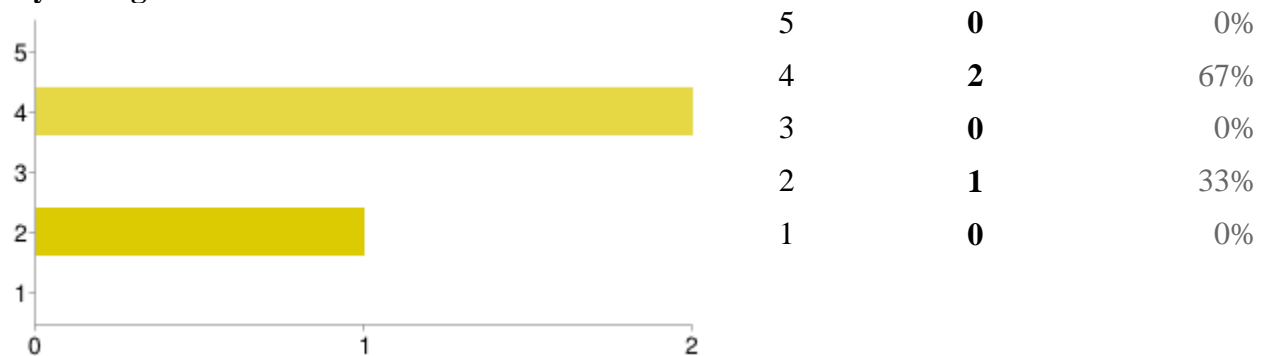
Rate the following websites based on which website had the best functionality for finding daily assignments and homework. - Task #1 Website - left hand navigation, blog post style assignments



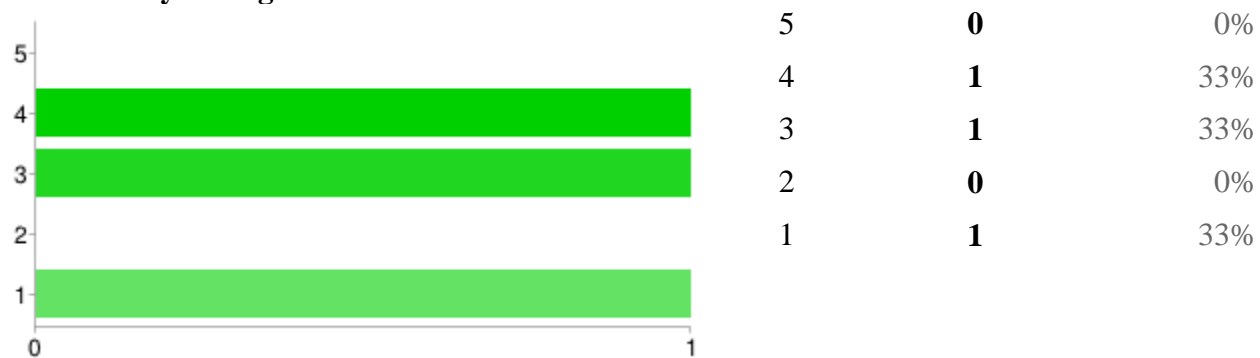
Rate the following websites based on which website had the best functionality for finding daily assignments and homework. - Task #2 Website - left hand navigation, calendar style assignments



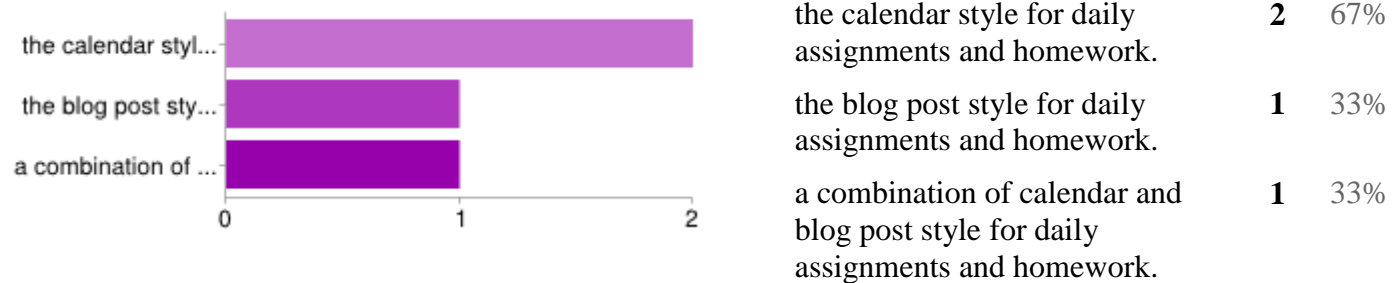
Rate the following websites based on which website had the best functionality for finding daily assignments and homework. - Task #3 Website - right hand navigation, blog post style assignments

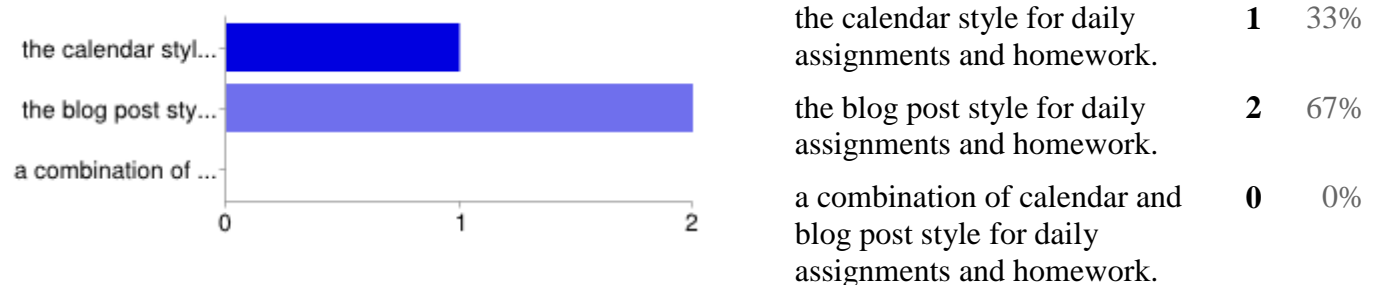
